Air Mail To Halifax, Nova Scotia 1921

Posted November 26, 1921 at St. Johns Newfoundland. Received Halifax February 4, 1922. Winters in Newfoundland were severe...many towns and villages were isolated all winter from outside contact and mail...mail by airplane seemed to be a solution....but early planes were not reliable. Early attempts like the one below ended up being delivered by surface means after considerable delay...in this case over 2 months.
